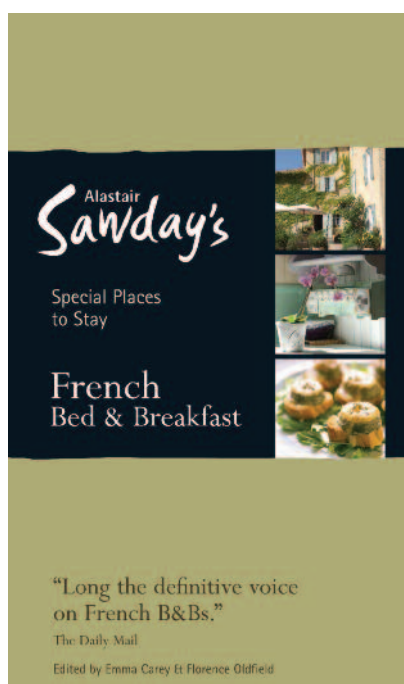

What a view! Sit here, gazing past palms and pool to the plunging sea and enjoying Yvette's speciality of the day (tart, crumble...). She is a wonderful woman, sprightly and endlessly caring; Guy, a gentle and invaluable member of the team, collects the fresh bread and helps you plan your stay; they have travelled lots and simply love people. All three pretty, pastel guest rooms lead off a bright, Moroccan-touched landing – brass lamps, hand-painted mirror – and have lovely rugs on honeycomb-tile floors. The biggest room is definitely the best. And a sandy beach is 10 minutes down the cliff. *Minimum stay 2 nights.*

Monsieur Georges is passionate about painting, music, wine and old houses and has renovated and decorated this typical palm-strewn 1900s Riviera villa all by himself. Each appealing room has a personal touch – a big red parasol over a bed, a fishing net on a wall; some have little balconies for private aperitifs. His own paintings hang in the cosy sitting room, wines appear for the evening tasting (you can buy them too), the beach is over the road. Despite the road, you don't need a car: fly in, train in, take a taxi or come by bike. St Tropez is a boat-trip away – charming out of season. *Train station 10-minute walk.*
